



Broadband Grant Portal Fact Sheet

A look at the Federal Funding Account's web-based application portal

What is it?

The Broadband Grant Portal is an online gateway that streamlines the application and reporting process for the California Public Utilities Commission's (CPUC) Federal Funding Account.

What does it do?

The Broadband Grant Portal enables eligible entities to apply for Federal Funding Account grants online, submit payment requests, and submit required reports using a web-based system.

Projects previously designed with the CPUC's [Applicant Tool](#) can be saved and associated with applications in the Broadband Grant Portal.

The Broadband Grant Portal will first launch with the Federal Funding Account and will eventually expand to include other CPUC broadband grant programs. The commonality and accessibility of the Grant Portal will streamline the process for all programs it serves, allowing faster and more efficient analyses of grant applications.
