The Committee advises the Commission on the development, implementation, and administration of the California Lifeline program. The program provides subsidized telephone and broadband services to low-income households.

The Committee is composed of 11 members representing various communities and tribes throughout the state. Members reflect the diversity of California, including the rural and urban areas; culture, language, and ethnicity; experiences; backgrounds and more.

Generally, in-person and virtual meetings occur at varying locations across the state, on a quarterly basis.
