Attached is AT&T California's supplemental application to amend its state-issued video franchise to include the Town of Danville and the City of San Ramon. AT&T currently provides its U-verse TV service to both entities pursuant to Public Benefits Agreements that will expire December 31, 2011.

AT&T California already has a surety bond in the amount of \$500,000, so with the change made regarding bond requirements in D.08-07-007, no additional bond is required. As per General Order 169, VI.C.1, there is no fee required to amend a franchise to change the service territory.
