Dear Mr. Morris:

We are pleased to advise you that the internal reorganization transaction for Charter Communications is completed establishing CCO SoCal I and CCO SoCal II as the two new legal entities operating in California. As you know, Charter previously noticed the California Public Utilities Commission of the consolidation of Charter Communications Properties, LLC, Marcus Cable Associates, LLC, Long Beach, LLC, Falcon Cablevision, a California Limited Partnership, Charter Communications Entertainment II, LLC, Falcon Cable System Company II, LP ("FCSCII") and American Cable Entertainment Company, LLC as the entities included in the new CCO SoCal I entity. Dalton Cablevision, Inc. is the legal entity contributed to the new CCO SoCal II entity. Charter Communications, Inc. (Charter") remains the ultimate parent company. Charter is providing this notification of completion of the reorganization in accordance with Public Utilities Code section 5840(m).

We do not anticipate any change in senior or local management as a result of the reorganization. In addition, no changes have been made to our services, policies or operations as a result of the reorganization. Going forward, Charter's legal entities holding a video franchise in California are CCO SoCal I, CCO SoCal II, Falcon Telecable, a California Limited Partnership and FCSCII.

We previously provided the franchise census data, list of officers, affidavit, Shapefiles, reduction in boundaries, customer numbers and Ownership chart for the new legal entities. I am attaching an updated list of officers for your records.
